1. Exhaust ventilation hood system (three (3) nonworking light' bulbs).

Replace all nonworking light' bulbs.

Dust/dirt on Exhaust Ventilation System Mechanical Fans, and Courtin Fan on Exit Door:

- 1. Kitchen' prep and warewashing areas (dust/dirt on four (4) exhaust ventilation system).
- 2. Kitchen prep and warewashing areas (dust/dirt on four (4) mechanical fans).
- 3. Courtin Fan on Exit Door (dust/dirt on Courtin EXIT door).

Clean dust/dirt from all exhaust ventilation system, mechanical fans, and Courtin fan.

CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(6)(a). Adequate exhaust ventilation hood systems in food prep and warewashing areas shall be provided and designed. 50 foot candles shall be at surfaces where employees work with food and 20 foot candles shall be at surfaces where food is provided to consumers.
